MICHIGAN CHAMBER AGRICULTURE POLICY COMMITTEE

Michigan Chamber Agriculture Policy Committee Meeting met on Monday, April 12, 2010. The majority of the commodities were in attendance and held a very productive session. Thank you to chairs Paul Karlovich and Scott Lonier for their time and effort. The committee decided to meet three times yearly and will meet again in August and November. The 2011 meetings will occur in February, August and November. The committee voted to support HB 4838 a bill to allow on farm production of bio fuels for farm use.
