Michigan Food Companies Featured at Weekend Festival

The Michigan Department of Agriculture (MDA) will host a "Taste of Michigan" tent at the Michigan Antique and Collectible Festival, May 30-31, at the Midland County Fairgrounds in Midland. This is the first in a series of several events to be held across the state this summer featuring Michigan products at fairs, festivals and other agricultural tourism locations.

The 41st Michigan Antique and Collectible Festival will feature of 80 acres of antiques, treasures and collectibles. In addition to the "Taste of Michigan" tent, there will be a classic car show and swap meet, free antique appraisals, a coin and sports memorabilia building, and entertainment throughout the festival, featuring blues, folk/Americana and bluegrass bands.

Festival hours are Saturday 8 a.m.-6 p.m., Sunday 8 a.m.-4 p.m.

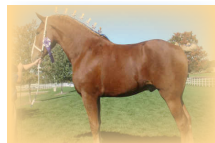
Admission is \$5 per person, with children ages 11 and under free.
