## FARM SERVICE AGENCY DESIGNATES 60 MICHIGAN COUNTIES AS AGRICULTURE DISASTER AREAS

### DECISION ALLOWS FARMERS TO RECEIVE EMERGENCY FARM LOANS

60 Michigan Counties have been designated as a natural disaster area due to storms with tornadoes, hail, and high winds that occurred from June 6 through June 15, 2008. The counties are Alcona, Allegan, Antrim, Arenac, Barry, Bay, Benzie, Berrien, Branch, Calhoun, Cass, Clare, Clinton, Crawford, Eaton, Genesee, Gladwin, Grand Traverse, Gratiot, Hillsdale, Huron, Ingham, Ionia, Iosco, Isabella, Jackson, Kalamazoo, Kalkaska, Kent, Lake, Lapeer, Leelanau, Lenawee, Livingston, Macomb, Manistee, Mason, Mecosta, Midland, Missaukee, Monroe, Montcalm, Muskegon, Newaygo, Oakland, Oceana, Ogemaw, Osceola, Oscoda, Ottawa, Roscommon, Saginaw, Sanilac, Shiawassee, St. Joseph, Tuscola, Van Buren, Wayne Washtenaw and Wexford.

This designation makes qualified farm operators in primary and contiguous disaster counties eligible for low-interest physical loss EM loans from the Farm Service Agency, provided eligibility requirements are met. Farmers in eligible counties have until February 25, 2009, to apply for the loans to help cover part of their losses.
