GRAIN ENGULFMENT SIMULATOR AND SAFETY SEMINAR AT 2010 AG EXPO

It takes a meager 15 seconds for a person to be covered waist deep in grain and only 30 seconds for their entire body to be submerged.

Knowing how to take action in these stressful situations could be the difference between life and death for many farmers and rescue personnel.

this year's Ag Expo will feature a grain engulfment simulator demonstration. The demonstration will address the issues of simple engulfment scenarios, how to avoid these scenarios and rescue methods to extract a victim from a grain bin.

The grain engulfment simulator presents a real-life simulation where a person will be rescued from an avalanche of flowing grain. Educational safety sessions will be held afterward to address other farm safety issues. The grain engulfment simulator is being sponsored by the Corn Marketing Program of Michigan and the Michigan Soybean Promotion Committee.

The Ag Expo runs from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., July 20 and 21, and 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., July 22. Admission to the grounds and parking at Farm Lane and Mt. Hope Road are free

Owners need to limit their exercise to early morning and evening on hot and humid days as asphalt becomes very hot, keep the water bowl refreshed, and be sure cooling shade is always nearby.


