Lt. Governor Cherry to Lead Town Halls in Lansing, Detroit and Royal Oak on Government Streamlining

Lt. Governor John D. Cherry, Jr. announced that he will be conducting town hall meetings in Lansing, Detroit and Royal Oak to obtain public input on streamlining state government. The public is invited and encouraged to attend and participate in the town halls scheduled from 6:00-7:30 p.m. each day as follows:

As part of the Granholm administration’s efforts to streamline state government, the lieutenant governor in May reported that a workgroup under his leadership has identified seven core functions of state government: public safety, education, public systems, well-being, sustainability, economic opportunity and prosperity, and efficiency and effectiveness. The lieutenant governor is now seeking input from citizens in a series of town halls across the state, state employees, and legislators to hear their perspective on what services a streamlined government should provide.

The lieutenant governor previously held town halls in Flint and Grand Rapids.
